The Museum of the City of New York is delighted to present its eleventh annual Louis Auchincloss Prize to Gloria Steinem, Whoopi Goldberg, and Michiko Kakutani.

Writer, journalist, and feminist activist Gloria Steinem has used her formidable writing talent in books, essays, and speeches to help spark a revolution in thinking about women and inspire new generations of women and men.

Author, comedian, actor, producer Whoopi Goldberg employs humor to speak the truth, becoming one of those rare individuals to earn a Grammy, Academy Award, Golden Globe, two Emmys, and a Tony.

Journalist and critic Michiko Kakutani was awarded the 1998 Pulitzer Prize for her "fearless and authoritative" journalism and served as the longtime *New York Times* Chief Book Critic.

The Museum's new exhibition *Beyond Suffrage: A Century of Women in New York Politics*, opening on October 11, 2017, traces women's political action in New York City from the struggle to win the vote, through the 20th Century and into our own times. The exhibition will be open for our guests during the gala dinner.

Disciplines include literature, architecture, art, music, playwriting, and photography. The Prize honors Louis Auchincloss (1917-2010) for his many years of service to the Museum of the City of New York as well as for his literary contributions that established him as one of the leading American novelists of the 20th and 21st centuries. Louis Auchincloss accepted the first Prize himself in 2007.
